## STARTING

A line between the mainmast of the Committee Vessel moored off Port Bannatyne and a Racing Mark. The Racing mark to be left to PORT.

## COURSE

Starting line – Toward Bank Buoy No 35 (S) – Portachur Point (Tann Spit) South Cardinal No.38 (P) – Laid inflatable Race Mark (Position 55° 32.00' N., 04° 49.50' W.) (P) – Finishing line (26M)

## FINISHING LINE

A line between the Mill Rock Red Can Buoy and the "Dolphin" on the outer most point of the main harbour pier. The "Dolphin" is a round structure used as a large ship fender at the end of the main harbour pier. The Mill Rock Red Can Buoy should be left to Port and the Dolphin to Starboard. See below for local information and dangers.

## LOCAL INFORMATION AND DANGERS

Lappock Rock lies approx. 3 cables due North of the harbour entrance, the area surrounding Lady Rock especially to the North has rock patches, Mill Rock lies a short distance to the North of the Mill Rock Buoy and the area to the South and West of the harbour entrance has rock patches. The area shore side and to the East of the finish line shallows quickly and care should be taken on approach to the main harbour entrance after finishing. The P&O Irish ferry may be arriving or departing during a yachts finish or starting time, all yachts should make themselves aware of the P&O vessels movements. The Troon harbour Master or a CCC representative may make a VHF announcement in the interest of safety. All of the above should be noted as local dangers. In order to avoid close quarter situations please keep to the STARBOARD side of the harbour channel entrance when arriving and departing Troon Yacht Haven.

## SHORTENED COURSE

In accordance with General Regulation 12, competing yachts shall take their own time when Portachur South Cardinal Buoy No. 38 bears 90 degrees M and again when the Laid Mark Buoy has a bearing of 90 degrees M. The yacht ahead and astern should be identified, their times estimated and added to the form on both occasions. Complete the declaration form in the 2009 Year Book and hand it to the Race Officer at Troon by 19.00hrs.

The race may also be shortened by a Committee Vessel displaying Flag S at any of the marks on the course. If the course is to be shortened for certain classes only, in addition to the provisions of RRS 32 (Flag "S") Class Flag(s) may be flown to indicate which Class (es) is/are being shortened. The Committee vessel will endeavour to make sound signals to draw attention to the flags as boats approach the line. The finishing line will be between the main mast of the Committee Vessel and the mark.

## MEMBER AT THE HELM

General Regulation 1.2 will **NOT** apply in this race. The race is open to members of all RYA/ISAF affiliated yacht clubs. Entrants who are not members of the CCC will not be eligible for any CCC trophies or CCC Championship points. Entrants who are not CCC members will be eligible for any sponsor's prizes which may be provided. Yachts must have a valid IRC or CYCA handicap certificate dependant on the class that they enter

## TIME LIMIT

Racing will cease at 18.00 hours. Any yachts still racing at this time will be treated as having retired. If, however, one yacht in any class has finished by the time limit, racing for all classes will be extended by 1 hour.

## RESULTS

Results will be displayed in the Troon Marina Office.

## TROON YACHT HAVEN

Harbour dues in Troon Yacht Haven are included in the entry fee. All yachts should call Troon Yacht Haven on VHF Channels 37 or 80 to be assigned an appropriate berth. The Yacht Haven can also be contacted by telephone on 01292-315553.

### STARTING LINE

A line between the Mill Rock Red Can Buoy and the "Dolphin" on the outer most point of the main harbour pier. The "Dolphin" is a round structure used as a large ship fender at the end of the main harbour pier. The Mill Rock Red Can Buoy should be left to Starboard and the Dolphin to Port. See above for previously stated information on local dangers. **Note. In the event that the P&O Irish ferry is due for departure or is manoeuvring at the race start times a delay may be signalled. All yachts should make themselves aware of the ferry movements. The Troon Harbour Master or a CCC representative may make a VHF announcement.**

### COURSE

Starting line – CPA HUN 14 (P)- CPA HUN 13 (S) – Finishing line (16M).

### FINISHING LINE

A line between the mainmast of the committee vessel moored north of the entrance to Largs Yacht Haven and FYC orange racing mark "K", the mark to be left to port.

### MEMBER AT THE HELM

General Regulation 1.2 will **NOT** apply in this race. The race is open to members of all RYA/ISAF affiliated yacht clubs. Entrants who are not members of the CCC will not be eligible for any CCC trophies or CCC Championship points. Entrants who are not CCC members will be eligible for any sponsor's prizes which may be provided. Yachts must have a valid IRC or CYCA handicap certificate dependent on the class that they enter

### TIME LIMIT

Racing will cease at 16.00 hours. Any yachts still racing at this time will be treated as having retired. If, however, one yacht in any class has finished by the time limit, racing for all classes will be extended by 30 mins.
