NOTICE OF RACE

Spring Regatta - 2010 Season

The CCC Dinghy Section Spring Regatta will take place on Saturday the 3rd of April, at Bardowie Loch. Four races are scheduled, weather permitting.

1. RULES.

CCC Dinghy Section Club Series races will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012, the prescriptions of the RYA, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.

2. ELIGIBILITY.

Racing is open to all members of the Dinghy Section who have attained RYA level 2 or equivalent, and competitors from clubs affiliated to the RYA.

3. CLASSES

All classes of monohull club owned and privately owned boats may be entered. Racing will be on a handicap basis using the Portsmouth ratings published by the RYA.

4. ENTRY.

Helms must register by completing an entry form in the clubhouse by 10.00am on Saturday the 3rd of April 2010. The cost will be £15.00 per boat for adult helms and £10.00 per boat for juniors, <18 years of age.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES.

Four races are scheduled. The first warning signal will be at 11.00am. Race 1 and 2 will be back to back, followed by a break for lunch. Races three and four will be back to back after the break. Starting sequence will be:

Albacore Class, warning signal at 11.00am

Fast Handicap Fleet, PY<1100, warning signal at 11.03am

(examples being, Merlin Rocket, National 12, RS200, Phantom, Laser Std Rig, Laser 2K)

Slow Handicap Fleet, PY≥ 1101, warning signal at 11.06am

(examples being Solo, Streaker, Topper, Pico, Laser Radial)

Note if there are insufficient entries for a class, the Race Officer may decide to merge classes.

9. SCORING SYSTEM.

The Low Point System RRS Appendix A4 shall apply. Full details are in the sailing instructions.

11. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS.

Sailing Instructions will be available on the club website, and will be available at registration.

12. Insurance and Responsibility

Competitors of private boats must have third party insurance of at least £2,000,000.00.

CCDS members racing club boats will be covered by CCDS club insurance.

The race organizers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage personal injury or death, however caused, to the owner or crew as a result of their taking part in the event.
