MODIFICATION TO THE GENERAL REGULATIONS

1 Yachts competing in this race shall not set spinnakers, twin headsails or cruising chutes.

2 All yachts shall race under their CYCA handicap rating.

3 Yachts may fly the class flag pennant under which they normally sail other CCC inshore championship races. If racing as a guest yacht in this race the appropriate class pennant should be displayed on the yachts backstay as befits the yacht's handicap as shown in the CCC 2008 yearbook.

RACE AND STARTING SIGNALS

A sound signal will be made at 3 **Minute** intervals indicating a START from 11:15 until 12.00 then a sound signal will be made every 2 **Minutes** indicating a START.

The class flag Pennant 1 will be displayed for ONE minute BEFORE the starts at 11.33,11.48,12.02 and 12.16 and will be lowered with the sound signal at the start.

RECALLS

Altering CCC General Regulation 7.1, no recall signals will be made; any yacht over line at its start will be classed as a non-starter

STARTING TIMES

Yachts shall race under CYCA handicaps

Yachts with CYCA handicaps ending in 0.25 or 0.75 shall start at the time appropriate to yacht with handicaps 0.25 LOWER e.g. handicap 16.25 starts with 16 minutes per hour.

STARTING LINE

A line between the mainmast of the Committee Vessel moored north of the entrance to Kip Marina, Inverkip and the southernmost racing mark offshore, the mark to be left to STARBOARD.

COURSE

Starting Line – Toward Bank Buoy (green conical No. 35) (S) – Ardyne Point Buoy (green conical) (P) – Ardmaleish Point Buoy (north cardinal) (P) – Finishing Line (13.1 M).

FINISHING LINE

A line between the mainmast of the Committee Vessel moored Northwest of the ferry slip at Colintrave and Rubha Bodach Buoy (green conical), the buoy to be left to PORT.

MEMBER AT THE HELM

General Regulation 1.2 will NOT apply in this race. The race is open to all yachts of any club that have a valid CYCA handicap certificate. If no handicap certificate is available please report to the CCC race secretary for further details.

MINIMUM EQUIPMENT

Yachts shall comply with the ORC/ISAF Special Regulations, Category 5 Appendix J.

SPINNAKERS SHALL NOT BE FLOWN IN THIS RACE

TIME LIMIT

Racing will cease at 17.00hrs. The winning yacht shall be the first yacht in the race to pass the finish line within the time limit. If no yacht has passed the finishing line within the time limit then the following shall apply. As this is a pursuit race if a yacht has not crossed the finishing line within the time limit a yacht's final position will be determined by its position on the racecourse. Yachts shall complete the declaration form and at 17.00 hours note the yacht immediately ahead and immediately behind. The declaration must be handed to the Race Officer by 19.00 hrs.

Muster – Saturday 6 September 2008

There will be a change from previous years for the Saturday 6th September evening muster. Details of the evening muster will be confirmed in Tidelines and also published on the CCC web site prior to the event.

Sunday 7 September 2008

On Sunday, weather permitting, a raft-up will be organised at lunchtime in a sheltered location. The Muster will be opposite or close to Colintrave with the location broadcast on VHF Channel 37 at 10.00 am. This will be open to all members and non-members who wish to take part. A format, similar to the Opening Muster, will be tried this year with a small number of boats forming the raft and all other members encouraged to anchor nearby and come aboard the raft using the yacht's dinghy. If your dinghy is not inflated please hail the raft before anchoring!

It is hoped that members will not be shy! Please do come on board. If you could bring with you a small quantity of liquid refreshment or nibbles this would be most welcome!
