- 3 All yachts shall race under their CYCA handicap rating.
- 4 Yachts may fly the class flag pennant under which they normally sail other CCC inshore championship races.
- 5 Classes 1 & 2 CYCA Handicap Bands rating 0-14.75, Classes 3 & 4 CYCA rating 15.00 and above

A line between the mainmast of the Committee Vessel moored off Port Bannatyne and a Racing Mark., the Racing mark to be left to PORT.

## MINIMUM EQUIPMENT

Yachts shall comply with the ORC/ISAF Special Regulations, Category 5 Appendix J.

## COURSE

Starting line – Toward Bank Buoy No 35 (S) – Mountstuart Buoy RW (S) – CPA Channel Buoy HUN 1 (S) – CPA Channel Buoy A (S) – Finishing Line (11.5 M)

## TIME LIMIT

Racing will cease at 16:30 hours. Any yachts still racing at this time will be treated as having retired. If, however, one yacht in any class has finished by the time limit, racing for all classes will be extended by 1 hour.

## FINISHING LINE

A line between the mainmast of the Committee Vessel moored off The Eileans, Great Cumbræ and Sheanawally Point on Little Cumbræ, the committee vessel to be left to PORT.
