General Regulation 3.6 will NOT apply. The race is open to members of all RYA/World Sailing affiliated yacht clubs. Yachts must have a valid IRC or CYCA handicap certificate dependent on the class they enter.

The start line will be between the mainmast of the CV moored to the north of the entrance to Inverkip Marina and

the southernmost racing mark offshore, the mark to be left to Starboard.

Yachts should identify themselves to the RO before the start.

THE FINISH

The finishing line will be between the Hunterston Channel Buoys

No 13: 55° 42.542 N, 4° 55.561 W and

No 14: 55° 44.535 N 4° 55.147 W

Yachts should take their own times and record these on a declaration form in accordance with General Regulation 10.3.

Times should be submitted to Racing Secretary Peter Edmond 07899 980169 immediately after finishing so that results can be published asap.

TIME LIMIT

The time limit for all classes will be 09:00 Sunday 10th June

MINIMUM EQUIPMENT

Yachts shall comply with World Sailing OSR Category 3 and in addition shall carry a liferaft or dinghy with sufficient capacity to carry all persons on board, minimum equipment as per OSR 4.20.2 c) and recommendations of OSR 4.21

Grab Bags. (See CCC General Regulations 5.4)

RETIRALS

The skipper of a yacht which retires from the race should advise the Racing Secretary (as above) asap or HM Coastguard who will pass on the details to him.
