

Bute Race Saturday 1st May 2021 Inverkip to Largs - Inshore Championship Race 1 2-Handed Series Race 1*

RULES

General Regulation 3.6 will NOT apply. The race is open to members of all RYA/World Sailing affiliated yacht clubs. Yachts must have a valid IRC or CYCA handicap certificate dependent on the class that they enter. **Please note the newly amended General Regulations 7 and 10 about monitoring the Race at all times on Channel 77.**

*Yachts wishing to enter the 2-Handed Series are asked to make this clear on entry, as well as in which class they wish to sail.

COURSE

All classes will sail Course 1 unless Flag G is displayed at the start when all classes will sail Course 2.

Course 1: Start – Toward Point Buoy (East Cardinal) (S) – Ardmaleish Point Buoy (P) – Rubha Bodach Buoy (green conical) (P) – Rubha Ban Buoy (red conical) (S) – Carry Buoy (red can) (S) – Inchmarnock (S) – Garroch Head (P) – CPA Portachur Buoy (green conical) (P) – CPA Channel Buoy HUN 1 (yellow can) (S) – Finish (37 M)

Course 2: Start – CPA Channel Buoy 1 (green conical) (S) – Toward Bank Buoy (green conical No 35) (P) – CPA Channel Buoy HUN 1 (S) – CPA Portachur Buoy (S) – CPA Channel Buoy B (S) – CPA Channel Buoy HUN 1 (S) – Finish (25M)

THE START

The start line will be between the mainmast of the CV moored to the north of the entrance to Inverkip Marina and the southernmost racing mark offshore, the committee vessel to be left to starboard and the mark to be left to Port.

THE FINISH

The finishing line will be between the mainmast of the committee vessel moored to the north of the entrance to Largs Yacht Haven and a racing mark, the mark to be left to Starboard. In the event that there is no committee vessel at the finish, yachts are to record their own times in accordance with General Regulation 10.3

TIME LIMIT

The time limit for all classes will be 18:00

If one yacht in any class has finished by the time limit, racing for all classes will be extended by 1 hour.
