

## Tarbert Race Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> August 2021 Largs to Tarbert - Inshore Championship Race 4

### RULES

General Regulation 3.6 will NOT apply. The race is open to members of all RYA/World Sailing affiliated yacht clubs. Yachts must have a valid IRC or CYCA handicap certificate dependent on the class they enter.

### COURSE

Start – Garroch Head(S) – Finish (25 M)

In accordance with General Regulations 10.3, competing yachts shall take their own time when the Ardlamont Point Buoy bears 090 degrees M. The yacht ahead and astern should be identified and their times estimated and recorded. In the event of no yacht finishing within the time limit these times will be used to produce race results and the information should be sent electronically to the Racing Secretary by 2000 hrs on 21<sup>st</sup> August (07899 980169 pfe263@gmail.com).

### THE START

The start line will be between the mainmast of the CV moored to the north of the entrance to Largs Yacht Haven and a racing mark, the mark to be left to Port.

### THE FINISH

The finishing line will be between a line between a pole on the south shore of the entrance to East Loch Tarbert (close to Rubha Loisgte) and Garbhaird point approx 335 degrees M on the north shore of East Loch Tarbert. In the event that there is no CV or RO at the finish yachts are to record their own times in accordance with General Regulation 10.3.

### TIME LIMIT

The time limit for all classes will be 18:00

If one yacht in any class has finished by the time limit, racing for all classes will be extended by 1 hour
