

# Tobermory Race 1<sup>st</sup> Leg (Inshore Championship Race 2) and Round the Mull Race - Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2021

## RULES

General Regulation 3.6 will NOT apply. The race is open to members of all RYA/World Sailing affiliated yacht clubs. Yachts must have a valid IRC or CYCA handicap certificate dependent on the class that they enter.

## COURSE 1 Rothesay to Ardrishaig for the Crinan Canal (see below for Course 2)

Start – Ardmaleish Point Buoy (P) – Rubha Bodach Buoy (P) – Rubha Ban Buoy (S) – Carry Buoy (S) – Ardlamont Point Buoy (S) – Sgat Mor (S) – Finish (28 M).

In accordance with General Regulations 10.3, competing yachts shall take their own time, firstly when the Carry Buoy bears 270 degrees M and secondly when Sgat Mor Light bears 090 degrees M. The yacht ahead and astern should be identified and their times estimated and recorded. In the event of no yacht finishing within the time limit these times will be used to produce race results and the information should be sent electronically to the Racing Secretary by 2000 hrs on 17th July (07899 980169 pfe263@gmail.com).

the West Side of Rothesay Bay and an inflatable racing mark, the buoy to be left to Starboard

Please watch for signals and listen on Ch 77 for announcements, as per amended General Regulations 7 and 10.

## THE FINISH

The finishing line will be a line on a bearing of 090 degrees M from the beacon on the end of the breakwater at the entrance to the Crinan Canal at Ardrishaig and, in accordance with General Regulation 10.3, all competing yachts should take their own time when they cross this line. This must then be sent electronically to the Racing Secretary by 2000 hrs on the 17<sup>th</sup> July. (07899 980169 pfe263@gmail.com).

## TIME LIMIT

The time limit for all classes will be 1800 hours.

If one yacht in any class has finished by the time limit, racing for all classes will be extended by 1 hour.

In accordance with General Regulations 10.3, competing yachts shall take their own time when the Mull of Kintyre Lighthouse bears 090 degrees M. The yacht ahead and astern should be identified, their times estimated and the information sent electronically to the Racing Secretary by 1800 hrs on 18<sup>th</sup> July. ## Tobermory Race 2<sup>nd</sup> Leg Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July 2021 - Inshore Championship

### Race 3

#### RULES

General Regulation 3.6 will NOT apply. The race is open to members of all RYA/World Sailing affiliated yacht clubs. Yachts must have a valid IRC or CYCA handicap certificate dependent on the class that they enter.

#### COURSE

Start – Craignish Point (S) – Ardluing Buoy (S cardinal) (S) – Grey Isles Lighthouse (Glas Eileanan) (P) – Green Isles Lighthouse (Eileanan Glasa) (P) – Calve Island (P) – Finish (40 M).

Competing yachts shall take their own time when the Grey Isles Light House bears 225 degrees M and when the Green Isles Light House bears 240 degrees M. The yacht ahead and astern should be identified and their times estimated. In the event of no yacht finishing within the time limit these times will be used to produce race results and the information should be sent electronically to the Racing Secretary by 2100 hrs on 19th July (07899 980169 pfe263@gmail.com).

The start line will be between the mainmast of the CV moored off the south west end of Eileen Righ, Loch Craignish, and a racing mark, the mark to be left to port. If there are light winds at the start, the CV may move the start line towards Tobermory, in which case only marks on the course between the new start line and Tobermory will apply.

Please watch for signals and listen on Ch 77 for announcements, as per amended General Regulation 7.

#### THE FINISH

All competing yachts shall take their own time when they cross a line bearing 225 degrees M to the northernmost point of Calve Island and this should be sent electronically to the Racing Secretary by 2100 hrs (07899 980169 pfe263@gmail.com).

There is a special berthing rate for competing yachts of £10 per night for Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> July.
